Savvy Skills for the Beginning Writer

How Listening Makes Us Better Writers

Three ways to increase your writerly listening skills:

- 1. Listen with your whole body and mind. Shut out the rest of the world and concentrate on the audible voice.
- 2. Listen with empathy. Put yourself in the speaker's shoes. What differences will this audible contribution make in your writing?
- 3. Listen with purpose. A writer's goal is to put themselves aside and write as the character.

Writer Exercise

- 1. Study the first scene in your story. Are you showing the story from the character's point of view or the writer?
- Examine your character's personality. What ways
 does he/she speak differently, analyze, differently,
 process information, experience sensory perception,
 and face life? Those traits affect how the character
 communicates.
- 3. Rewrite all passages that don't reflect the character. You can do it!
